

Job Opportunity-Security Guard

Full-time Seasonal Work (June to August) (with flexibility with start and end dates)

The successful person is a Customer Focused, positive, friendly individual, who places the customer experience as a priority, and is also willing to do duties to support the campground operation including washroom cleaning and other tasks. List of tasks and responsibilities are highlighted below, must also be willing to perform other tasks as required. Night Security staff members are responsible for the overall safety of the campground, and its guests. They provide a visual presence while maintaining a safe and secure environment.

Essential Duties:

- Ensure traffic control at the front gate (i.e. all vehicles must have a car pass)
- Conduct regular security patrols throughout the campground to ensure overall security; making sure facilities, buildings are locked and ensuring there is no suspicious activity occurring
- Efficiently and courteously respond to and manage guest questions and requests
- Address any noise complaints, making sure guests are compliant with the assigned quiet hours
- Routinely perform bathroom checks to ensure facilities are clean and in good working order
- Respond to emergency calls as required
- Follow all company safety and security procedures
- Complete daily written security reports. When performing regular rounds, accurately report times and findings for morning employees
- Balance cash at the end of the shift (i.e. sale of vehicle passes and wood bundles)
- Water the flowers at the front gate
- May be asked to perform other duties as required

Qualifications and Experience Required:

- Must be registered as a student or have completed the Community College diploma in security services or equivalent and/or have experience in a security services role
- Must have good communication skills, be focused on team work and the ability to work well with co-workers and campground guests
- Must also be able to work independently with minimal supervision
- Must have good sense of observation and be attentive to details
- The ability to diffuse situations using verbal communication skills is crucial
- The ability to think critically in emergency situations and use good judgment is imperative
- Must have the ability to maintain a high degree of confidentiality
- Must be able to communicate in both official languages
- Must be able to work evening, night and weekend shifts. Scheduling flexibility is required
- Able to work in a high pressure fast paced environment
- Must possess a valid driver's license
- First Aid, CPR Certification is considered an asset
